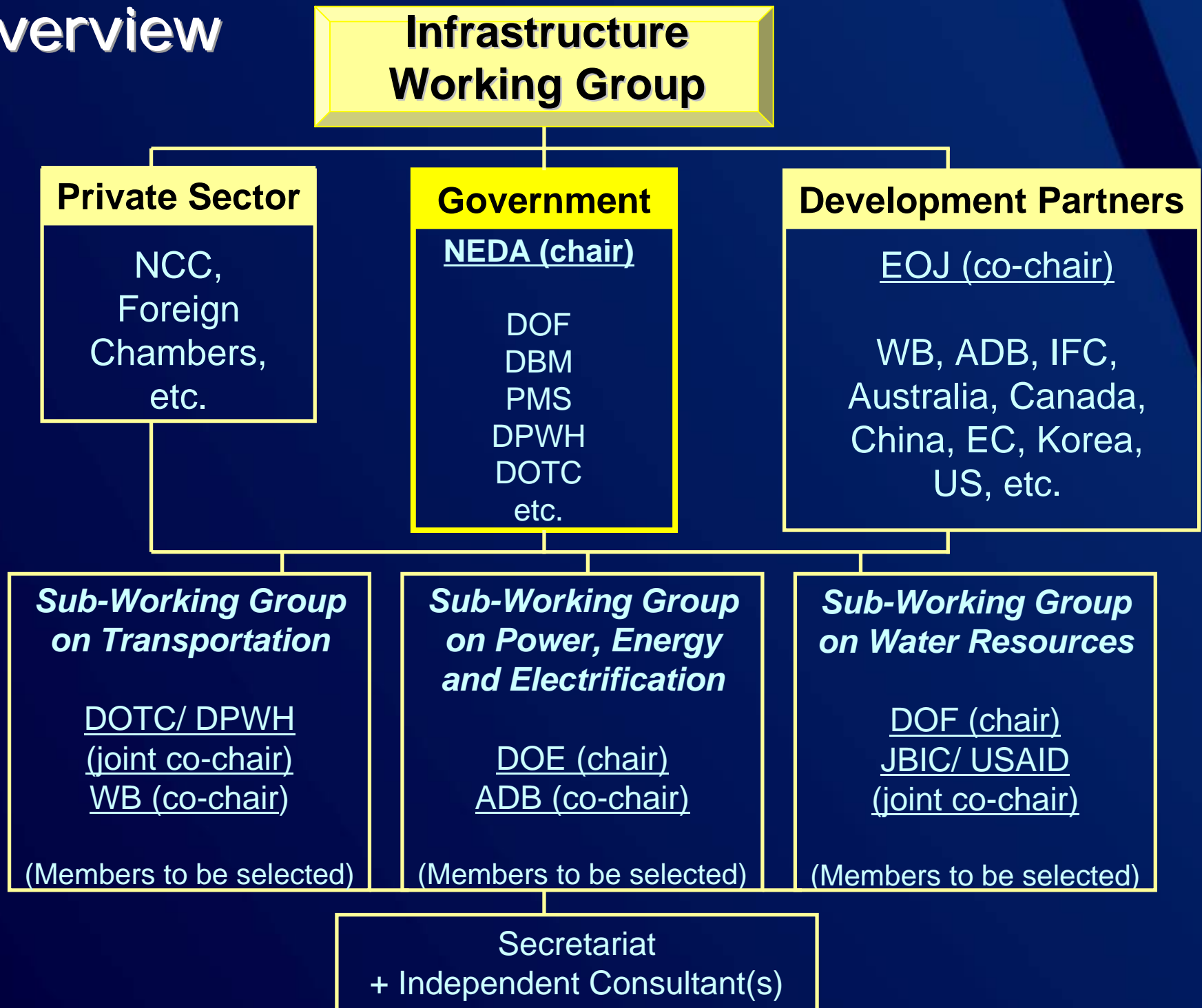

- 👉 Coordinate with the PMS and request reports on monitored 152 SONA Projects to be furnished to the Group
- 👉 Enhance PDF Infra WG organization
 - More sectors to be covered in the future (Communications, Social Infrastructure etc)

II. Work Agenda (Draft)

A. Institutional Initiative

- ➡ Designate and harness champions at national and local levels to push initiatives in water resources management
- ➡ Strengthen the role of CSOs in project monitoring
- ➡ Address the lack of regulation on local government-run utilities
- ➡ Strengthen the NWRB through increased budgetary and manpower support

B. Policy Designing

- 👉 Review existing and proposed bills to harmonize/synchronize the legislative agenda on water
- 👉 Planning and budgeting harmonization
- 👉 Optimize use of IT tools for planning and budgeting

C. Private Participation

- 👉 Improve incentives for private sector participation in water supply services
- 👉 Develop financing mechanisms to leverage public resources with private financing in water supply
- 👉 Improve capacity for PPP project development for line agencies and project evaluation for oversight agencies
