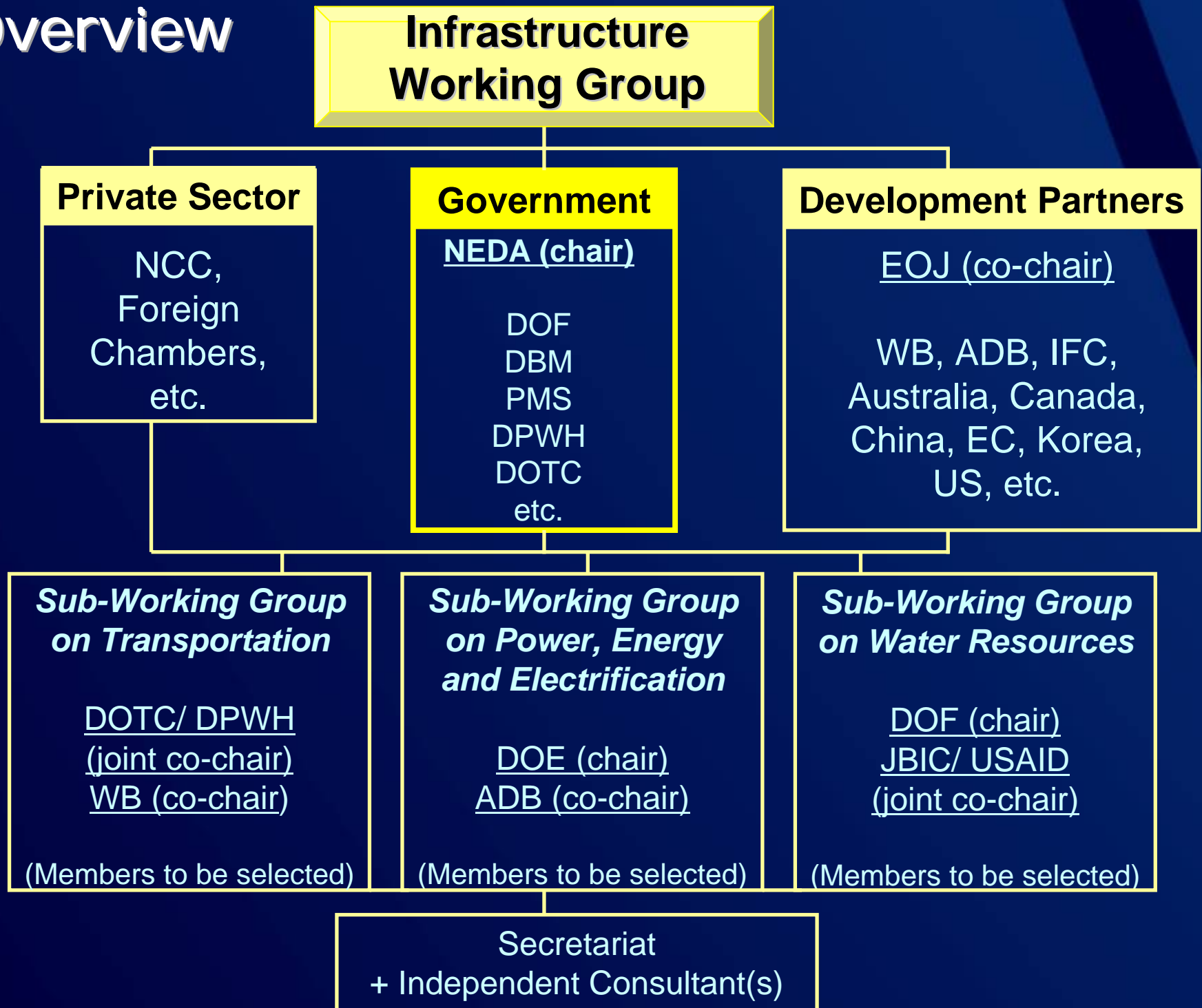
- 👍 Fast-track infrastructure projects through resolution of technical and legal issues
