### **I. BACKGROUND**

- CARP ends in June 2008
- Land balances for distribution: 1,007, 538 has.
  - DAR – 1,007,538
  - DENR– 700,000
- No executive and legislative decision on the issue up to this point in time.

**2. DAR proposes for another ten-year extension with a total budget requirement of**

- 4.3 Study on land administration reform and rural development (World Bank)**
- 4.4 Harmonize and fast track support services delivery to be linked to Convergence Initiative**

- DAR/DENR to harmonize planning processes in CBFM and ARCs**
- Support of GTZ to be solicited**

### **5. Prepare for exit mechanism should there be no extension**

- Take stock of GTZ-sponsored study on POST-LAD and the World Bank studies on logical actions to take, i.e., policies and institutional arrangement**
- Rural Development and Poverty Reduction Strategy (planned World Bank study)**
- Land Administration Reform and Rural Development (study proposal by the World Bank on which collaboration with other partners is sought)**
- Support of GTZ and World Bank to be solicited**
