SNPRC MANDATE

- Undertake a study of causes, costs and actions to be taken in the wake of Frank, Ondoy and Pepeng
- Seek fresh aid to fund the reconstruction; tap the resources of the private sector
- Recommend to the President reconstruction and rehabilitation projects
- Oversee the implementation of the reconstruction program
- Act as a clearing house for the international assistance implemented by the donors

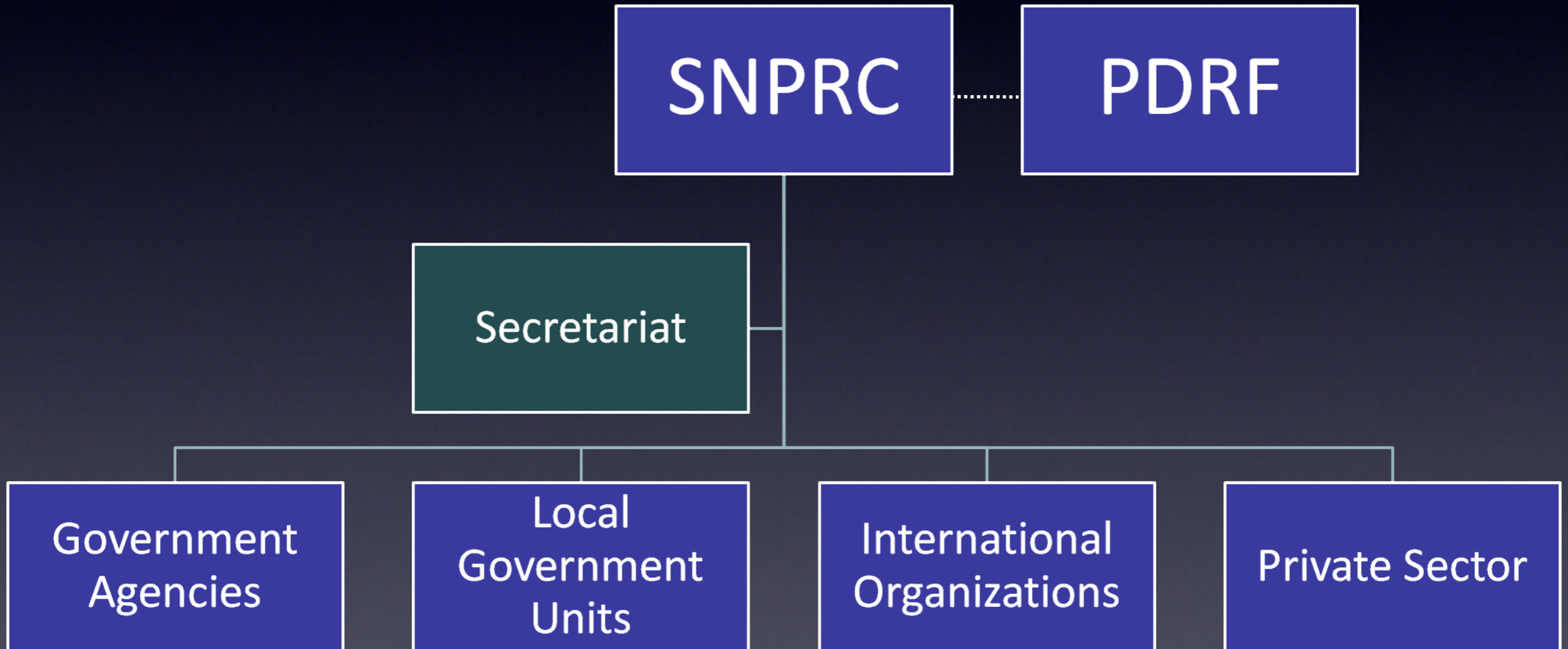

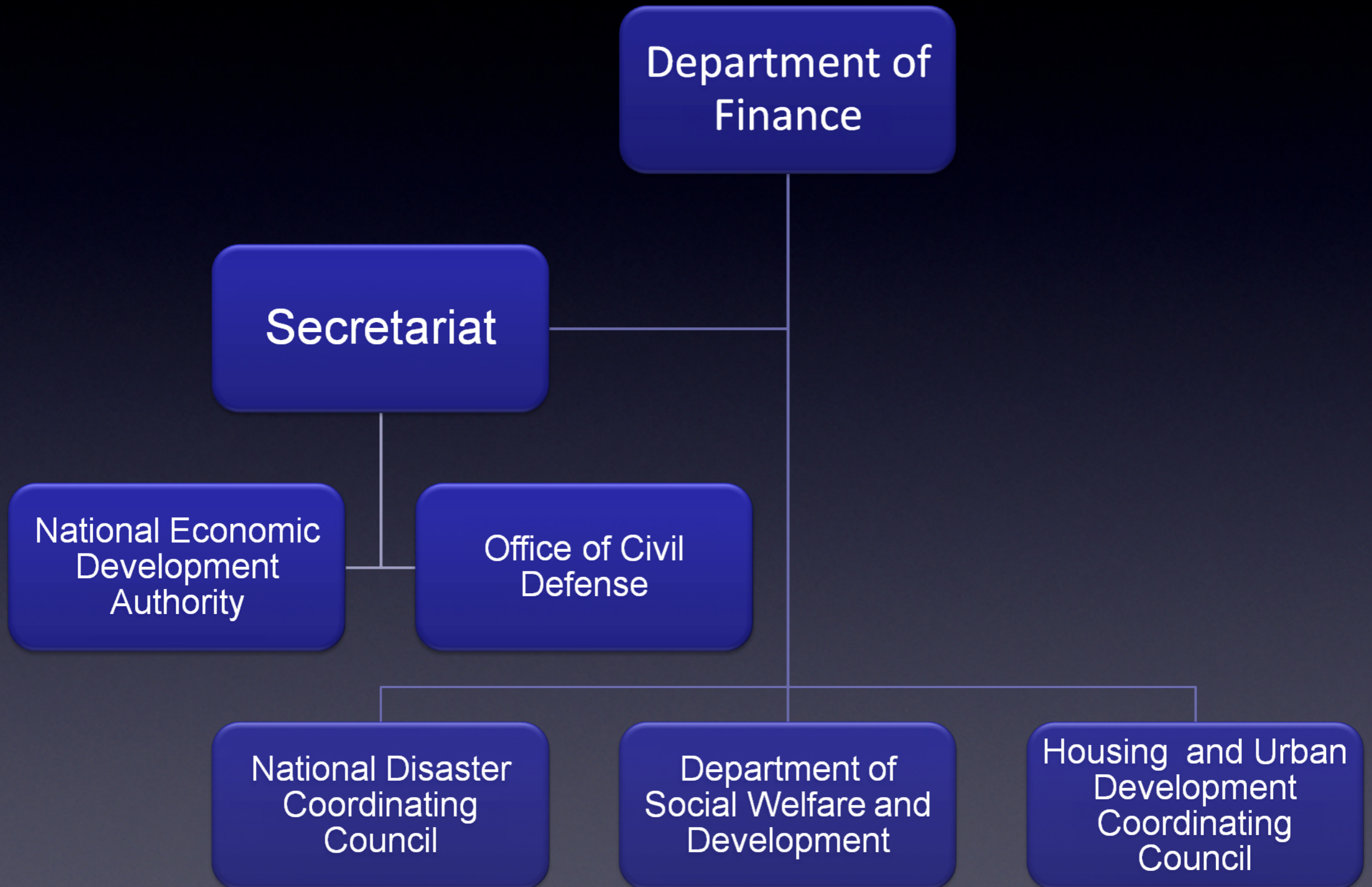


COOPERATION AGREEMENT

- Set out the procedure under which each party will monitor and coordinate the implementation status of both the government and private sector projects



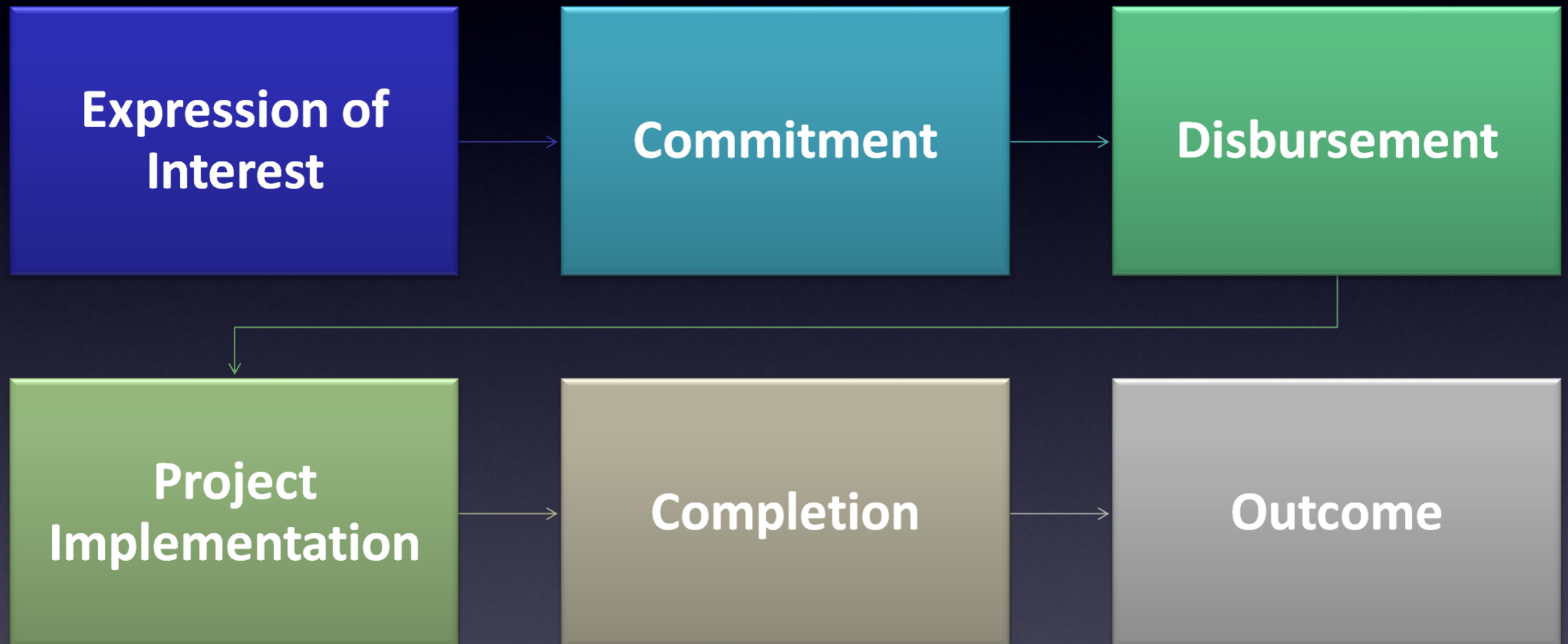
SNPRC COMPOSITION
