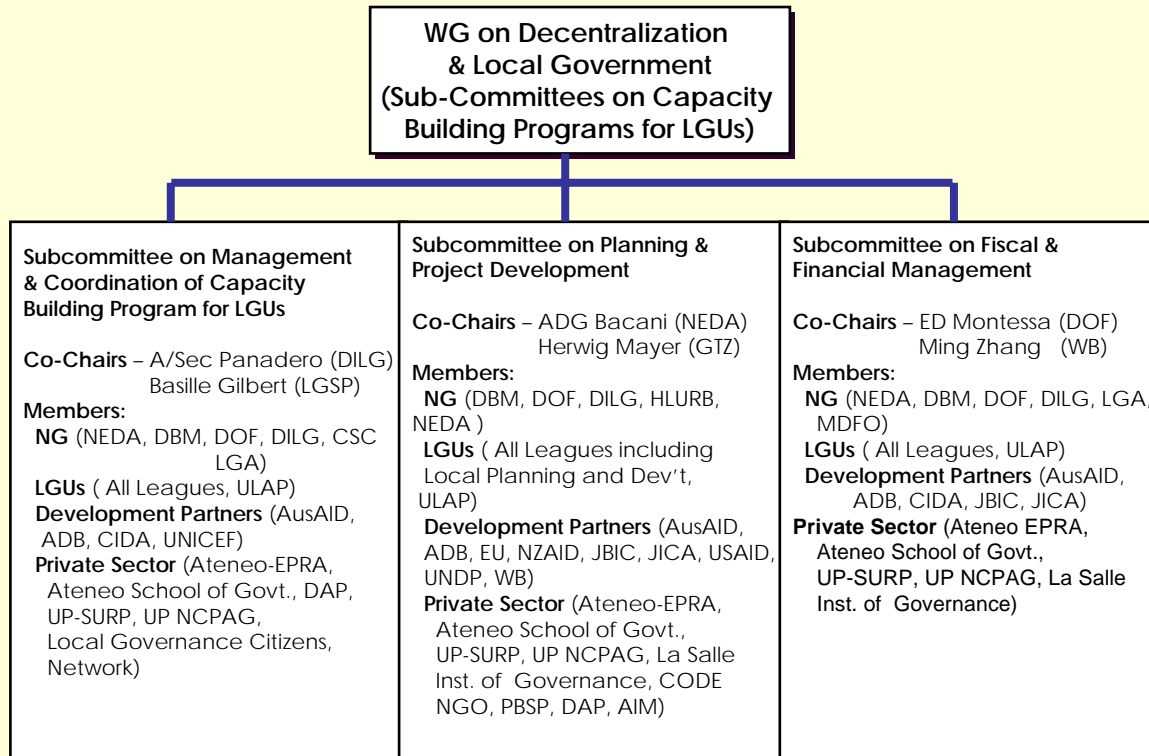

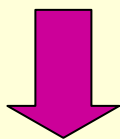


EXPECTED OUTPUTS OF THE SUBCOMMITTEES ON CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

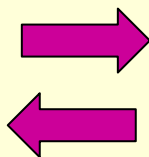

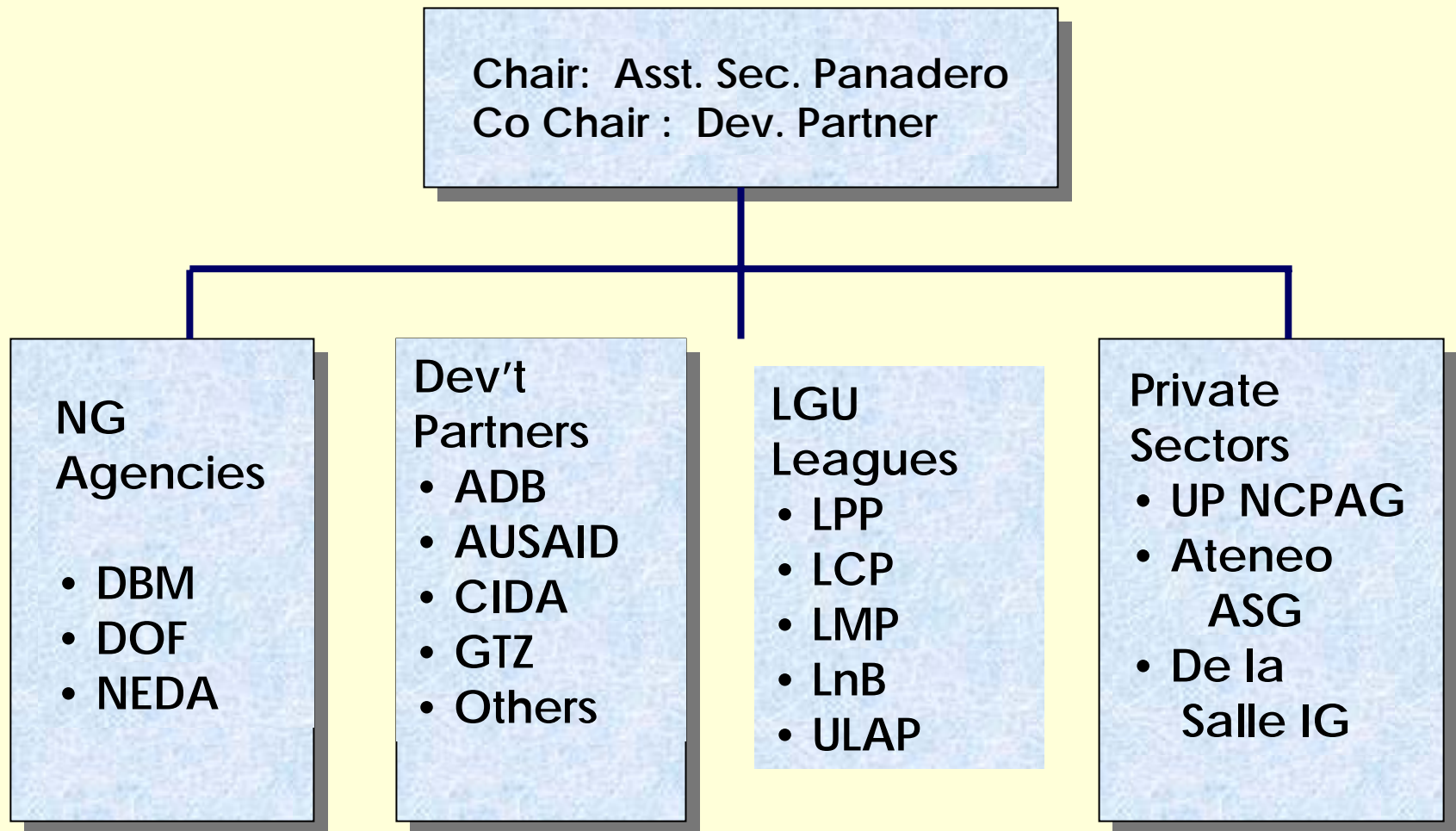

PROPOSAL

- Merge the three Subcommittees into just one Subcommittee on Harmonizing Capacity Building Programs for LGUs
 - Simplified structure would facilitate coordination
 - Easier to manage in terms of logistics

PROPOSED ACTION PROGRAM FOR 2007

Capacity Building

- Prepare a harmonized capacity building program for newly-installed Local Chief Executives and their staffs
- Work towards the implementation of the Joint Memorandum Circular, including the roll-out of core manuals
- Develop capacity building programs on the management and coordination of ODA for LGUs
- Formulation of a multi-donor program support for project development for LGUs
- Continue capacity building programs for oversight agencies and LGU Leagues
- **Study on the conceptual and operational framework for capacity building programs for the local government sector**
