- Monitor & report anticorruption progress

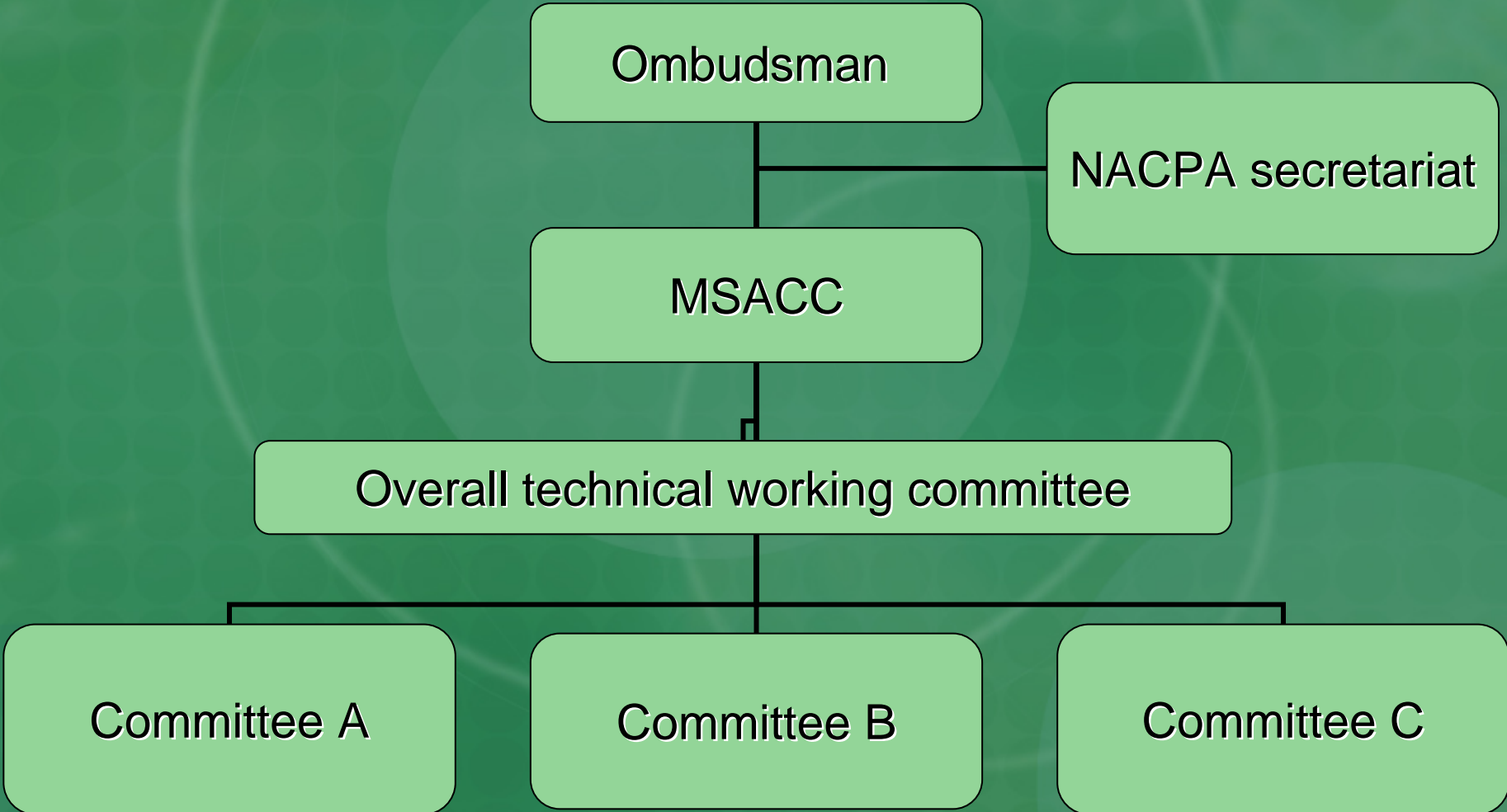

MSACC in focus: IDR

Integrity Development Review

- Compendium of corruption prevention tools
- Assesses corruption vulnerability in agency systems, business processes and services
- Guides the agency in designing & deploying system safeguards to capture & prevent corruption

IDR 2007

- DENR** operationalize forest stock management system; proactive monitoring of compliance with environmental compliance certificate conditions and cascade community-based monitoring protocols; address poor revenue collection on foreshore lease rentals and occupancy fees and completion of survey of foreshore areas
- DAR** provide an appeal process in land use conversion cases decided by the regional director and promote third-party involvement in field investigation report preparation; background check and performance assessment of agrarian case adjudicators and DARAB personnel
- LRTA** set up surveillance camera in ticket processing area; replace broken crates which compromise ticket count; formulate guidelines in handling discrepancy between station gate collection and production reports; tighten warehouse security setup
- NIA** e-systems for irrigation service fee billing and collection, project implementation and procurement management; maintenance of updated computerized database of irrigated and planted areas; periodic update of force account management infrastructure system
- PVAO** systems enhancement to include full audit trail in old age pension processing; periodic revalidation of database, spot checks, fast track “one-veteran file” system; service standards setting

IDR 2007...

- AFP-PN** Revisit training program to include financial management as a mandatory generic managerial tool for all commissioned officers in all levels of training starting with PMA; clarification in the formulation process of defense planning guidance and the annual procurement plan; procurement contract template development
- BuCor** Enhance individualized rehabilitation program for inmates; policy on relational boundaries between prison personnel and inmates; limit tour of duty / rotation of prison guards; transparency in recruitment; third-party expert assessment of economic and security aspects and social impact audit of joint venture agreements of prison agro industries
- BFP** spot checks and review of monthly fuel consumption report; set up internal audit to monitor procurement and distribution of supplies and equipment; computerize inventory system; rotation of fire safety inspectors; improve communications system
- LRA** Improve records management system and reduce face to face interface with clients; simplify work processes; install document tracking system
- DBM-PS** spot audit of stock card data entries; stringent measures to monitor supplier performance and impose blacklisting; guidelines for hiring through job orders; transparency in recruitment; customized regularization policy

IDR 2007...

- Establishment of monitoring units – the Integrity Development Committees (IDCs)
- Monthly reportorial requirements
- Periodic assessments and expansion of corruption vulnerability assessments to cover all operational areas
- Coordination with DBM in making IDR exercise as a benchmark good housekeeping measure in the bureaucracy and in the establishment of an incentives system to ensure sustainability
- Publication of IDR results
- Enforcement of recommendations
